




Installing and Running Your kSA Help File

k-Space has put significant effort into writing quality Help Manuals for your use. Our Help Manuals are hyperlinked to our software, so that whenever you have a question about a dialog, window, or chart, by clicking the F1 key the Help Manual will automatically launch and go to the description for that specific dialog, window, or chart that is currently active.

In order to incorporate the downloaded kSA Help Manual into your kSA software, please do the following:

1. Copy the Help Manual file (.chm) to the following kSA software folder: C:\Program Files (x86)\kSA\kSA xxx\Program, where xxx is the product name, e.g. 400, MOS, BandiT, RateRat, ICE, etc.
2. From within your kSA Program, click on the  toolbar icon. Does the Help Manual launch? If so, you're all set. If not, please feel free to contact us for further help.
3. Important note: F1 help is enabled w/ our Help Manuals. This means that whenever you have a dialog, window, or chart open and selected, by clicking the F1 key the Help Manual will automatically jump to that topic.
4. Alternatively, the .chm Help Manual can be accessed from outside the kSA program. Simple copy the .chm file to the desired location (e.g. your Desktop). Double clicking the file will launch the Help Manual.
5. Note: occasionally there is a security feature enabled on the Help file that must be disengaged: this is done by right clicking on the .chm file, selecting Properties, selecting the General tab, and clicking on the Unblock button:
